2. Drill Machine



Why it matters:

What it does:

- Drills holes
- Drives screws
- Speeds up installation

Pro Tip:

Use the right drill bit for wood to avoid damage.

3. Circular Saw (or Hand Saw)

Why it matters:

This is your primary cutting tool.

**What it does:**

- Cuts wood panels and boards
- Ensures straight, clean cuts

Pro Tip:

Use a guide or straight edge for precision cuts.

4. Hand tool kit

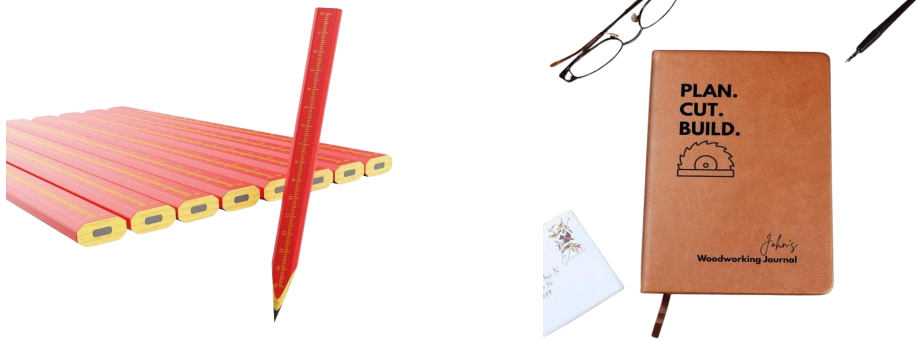
Why it matters:

Function:

Marks measurements and cutting lines. Uses:
